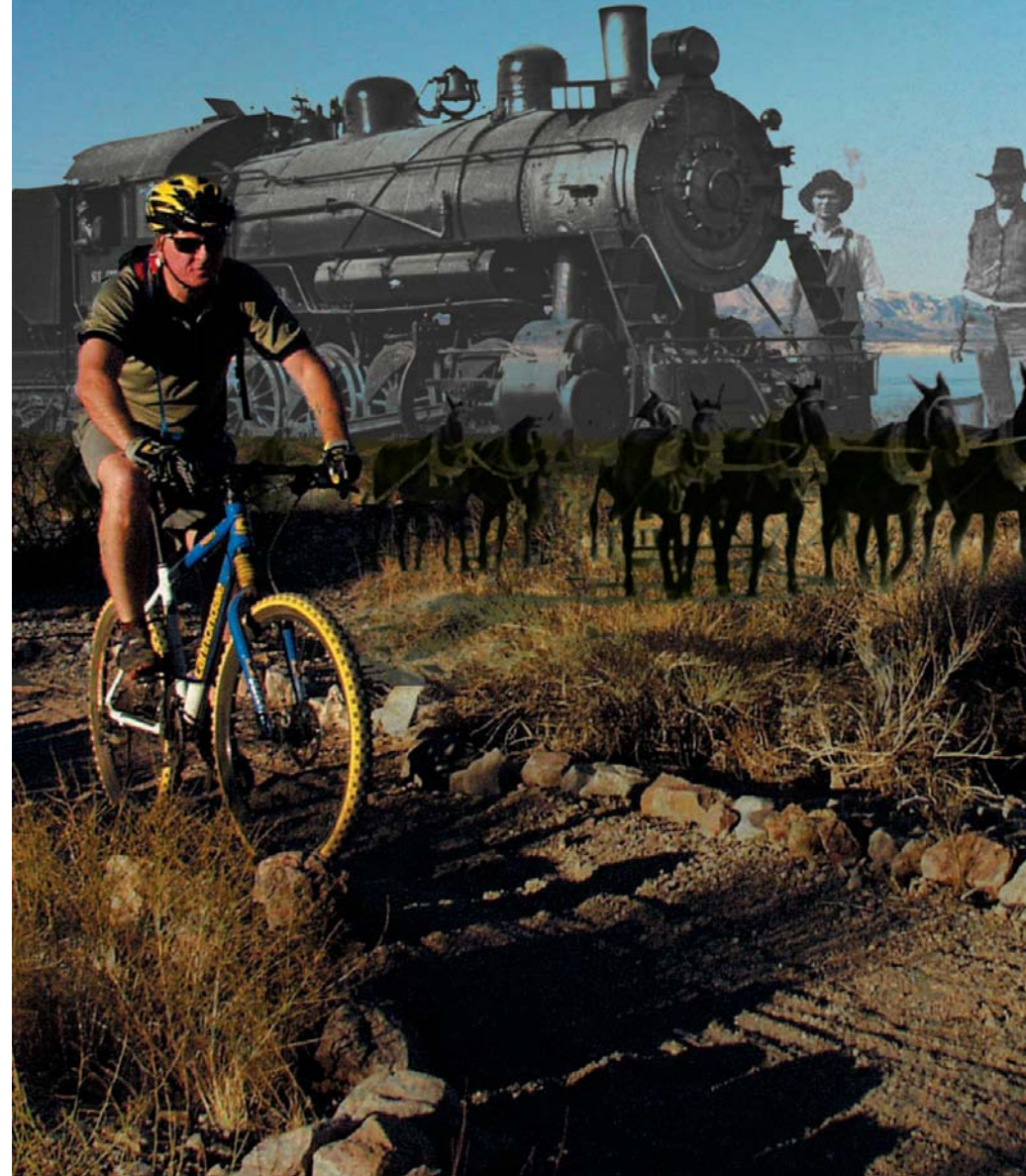

This newest spur trail off of the 35-mile River Mountains Loop Trail is seven miles long (14 miles round trip). Immediately after the ribbon-cutting ceremony at 11:30 a.m., the public is invited to take part in the inaugural bike ride or hike of the trail.

The River Mountains Loop Trail system, when completed in 2008, will connect Boulder City, Henderson, Lake Mead National Recreation Area, and Hoover Dam. The Trail System is a collaboration of the River Mountains Loop Trail Partnership, the National Park Service, the Bureau of Reclamation, Clark County, and the cities of Boulder City and Henderson.

Funding for this project comes from the Southern Nevada Public Lands Management Act, and other sources including: the National Park Service, the Bureau of Reclamation, the Federal Highway Administration, the Nevada Department of Transportation, and the city of Boulder City.
