



## The "Neon to Nature" System

- 760 miles of city off-street biking, walking, multi-use trails. Of this total, 145 miles are completed and open for your use. Find out where these trails are by attending National Trails Day.

An additional 155 miles are funded and in various stages of design and construction.

- 252 miles of federal lands off-street, walking, biking, multi-use non-motorized trails are available for your use.
- 185 miles of **on-street** bike lanes are open for bike use.
