



## **Trails in North Las Vegas – September 23, 2010 Update**

The City of North Las Vegas has 5.5 miles of existing regional trails developed along the Las Vegas Wash with an additional 3 1/2 miles scheduled to be complete by the end of 2010.

### **New Trails in 2010:**

-An additional 3/4 miles of trail was recently completed along the Lower Las Vegas Wash between Craig Road and Alexander Road. The Lower Las Vegas Wash Regional Trail within the City of North Las Vegas now spans over 5 miles from Tropical Parkway to Alexander Road.

-The newest segment of the trail system along the Upper Las Vegas Wash is expected to be complete in October 2010. It spans approximately 3 1/2 miles, from Deer Springs to Craig Road.

### **2011 Scheduled Trail Construction:**

The city has funding to construct an additional 5 miles of the Las Vegas Wash Regional Trail, for a total trail system of approximately 14 miles.

-Construction of the next trail project in CNLV is expected to be completed in September 2011. It will join the Upper Las Vegas Wash Trail and the Lower Las Vegas Wash Trail together, terminating just west of Losee Road. This is where it will eventually tie into the 1-15 Pedestrian Bridge Project that is expected to be complete in 2012. This bridge will provide an elevated pedestrian crossing over Losee Road, the UPRR, and the 1-15.

-The southernmost segment of the regional trail in CNLV between Las Vegas Blvd. and Lake Mead Blvd. will be constructed concurrently with flood control channel improvements and is expected to begin in 2011 and be complete by March 2012.
